The 2017 symposium focuses on “Archaeology of Tomorrow”- highlighting current research and projects from undergraduate and graduate students for all areas of the New World and Old World. This year, the symposium will kick off California Archaeology Month and will provide a venue for presenting research in spoken, poster, and video sessions. Presenters will be eligible to apply for a **300.00\*** grant that can be used for future participation in a conference of their choosing.



### Presenters

Please read the following recommendations carefully before submitting any abstract. The abstract must include:

- Title;
- Author(s); if more than one, please mark presenter with an asterisk (\*); Affiliation of (each) author;
- Summary of presentation;
- The abstract should be complete and informative (objectives, methods, results, conclusions);
- The text should have a maximum length of 200 words (font Arial, size 11);
- Line drawings, figures, graphs, charts, etc., should not be included;
- Author(s) wishing to present more than one abstract must submit separate submission forms;
- Author(s) applying for the Travel Grant must submit separate application forms.
